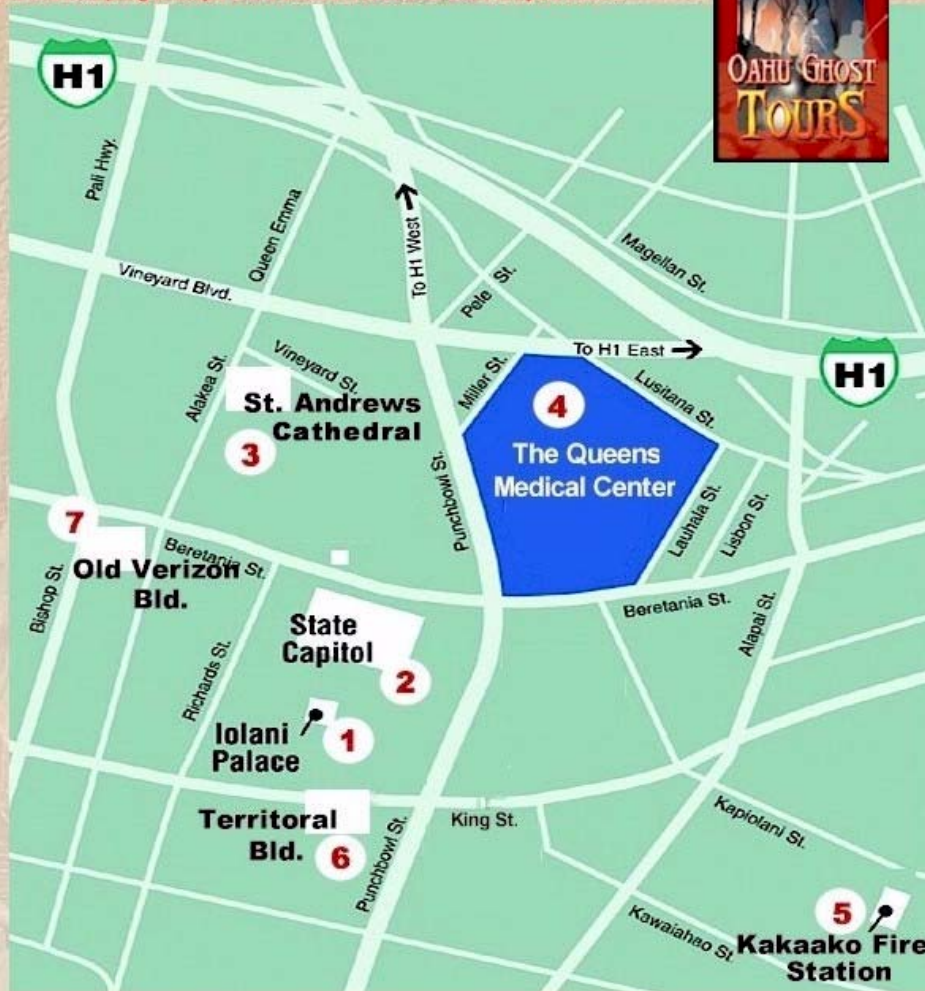


HONOLULU CITY HAUNTS TOUR

Note: This is a sampling of major sites visited. Additional sites may be added.



1. **Iolani Palace** - Ballroom dancing has been heard in the throne room upstairs at night. Unexplainable shadows and lights seen by security guards.
2. **State Capital Building** - Hawaii's beloved Queen Liliuokalani has been seen handing out lei's to visitors at the entrance. The ghost of a little boy haunts one of the offices in this building.
3. **St. Andrews Cathedral** - The spirit of Queen Emma has been seen roaming the corridors and street around the Cathedral.
4. **The Queens Medical Center** - It is said that downstairs in the morgue area, a lady wearing a red dress can be seen in the stairwell. Sometimes only the lower half of her is seen.
5. **Kakaako Fire Station** - It is said that the ghosts of an old man and his dog haunt this fire station. The man and his dog have been seen at the entrance, both with no head.
6. **Territorial Building** - At night, some say babies can be heard crying from within the building. It was once a location of an orphanage. Nearby, at the site of the old city morgue, some say you encounter cold, ghostly odors.
7. **Old Verizon Building** - In 1977, during the construction of additions to the then GTE Hawaiian Tel headquarters, a worker fell down the elevator shaft and died. Since then the elevators act erratically, taking you on "rides". Other ghosts have been seen and heard on the 10th floor by elevator operators.
